Hyoung-Joon Chang - Professor of Piano, Seoul National University.

Has performed with London Philharmonic Orchestra, Tokyo Philharmonic, Osaka Symphony, the Symphony Orchestra of Russia, Czech National Symphony, among other orchestras, under the baton of Thomas Sanderling, Walter Hendl, Tadaaki Otaka, Paul Freeman, Ian Hobson. Recitals on international stages in Europe, USA, Canada, Japan, and Korea. Recorded for Pro Arte, Genuin, and Warner Music labels. Taught master classes at leading schools, such as Manhattan, Eastman, Colburn Schools, Shanghai, Beijing and Sichuan Conservatories, Royal College in London, Royal Conservatoire of Scotland. Jury member in leading international piano competitions: Cleveland, Dublin, Seoul, Epinal, Shanghai, Astana, Dresden, Kiev, Tromso ("The Top of the World"). Numerous of his students won major and special prizes. Earned his doctoral degree at Manhattan School of Music, under the guidance of Earl Wild and Constance Keene.
