**Pavlina Dokovska.** Chair, Piano Department, the Mannes College, New School for Music, New York; founder and artistic director of Mannes Festivals and Southwest Virginia Festival for the Arts. First prizes at Claude Debussy Competition in France and International Competition in Senigallia, Italy. Among the orchestras appeared as soloist with: Dresden Philharmonic, Berlin Radio, Luxembourg Radio Symphony, Bratislava Symphony, Wroclaw Symphony, Havana Symphony, UNAM Orchestra (Mexico), St. Cecilia Chamber Orchestra, etc. Was heard on the important stages of the musical world: Avery Fisher Hall, Weill Recital Hall, Merkin Hall in New York, the National Gallery in Washington, Gardner Museum (Boston), Wigmore Hall (London), Salle Gaveau (Paris), La Scala (Milan), Beijing National Center for Performing Arts, National Opera Hall in Taipei, and others. Took part in such festivals as Salzburg, Spoleto, Klavierfestival Ruhr, Prague Autumn, Sofia Musical Weeks (Bulgaria), among others. Collaborated with the legendary Bulgarian basso Nicolai Ghiaurov, cellist Nathaniel Rosen, violinist Robert McDuffy. Studied with Lydia Kuteva and Julia and Konstantin Ganey in Bulgaria, with Yvonne Lefébure in Paris and Beveridge Webster at the Juilliard School, New York.
