Tami Kanazawa & Yuval Admony. Married couple, The Kanazawa-Admony Piano Duo has won the first prize in 5 international piano duo competitions: 2008 Oslo Prize in Concours Grieg, 2005 Menuhin Gold Prize in Osaka International Competition, 2002 IBLA GRAND PRIZE in Italy, 2001 Rome Prize and the 2000 Tokyo Duo Competition. Recipients of The Israel Minister of Culture Award for a Permanent Chamber Group.

Followed by rave reviews, appeared in over 25 countries including prestigious halls such as Carnegie Hall, New York, Argentina Theatre in Rome, Tokyo Metropolitan Festival Hall, Warsaw National Radio Hall, Budapest Congress Hall, Jerusalem Theatre and others. International Festivals include The Budapest Spring Festival in Hungary, Klavierduo Festival in Germany, Duets in The Baltic Sea in St. Petersburg, Odessa Dialogues in Ukraine, Asian Music Festival, The Israel Festival and more. Radio Broadcasts include BBC London, CBC Canada, Tokyo FM, NHK Japan, BNR Bulgaria, Budapest National Radio, Radio New Zealand, and Israel's "Voice of Music".

Tami & Yuval Admony teach piano duos at the Buchman-Mehta School of Music in the Tel Aviv University and have been invited to give piano duo master classes worldwide including; at The Norwegian Academy of Music, Korean National University of Arts, Japan National Piano Teachers Association, Pacific Rim Festival in Canada, Rimsky Korsakov Conservatory in St. Petersburg, Subotica Piano Fest in Serbia and elsewhere.

The duo appeared with Israel's' leading orchestras including; The Jerusalem Symphony Orchestra, Israel Symphony Orchestra, Israel Chamber Orchestra, Israel Kibbutz Orchestra, Israel Sinfonietta Beer Sheva, Raanana Symphonette, Israel Stage Orchestra and others. Their *Symphonic Poems* by Liszt with NAXOS Label was acclaimed in the music magazines Fanfare and International Piano. Latest release: *Rhapsodies for Two Pianos* with Romeo Record to be followed by *From Mozart to Gorezki* with the same Label.
