Victor Rosenbaum

Professor of piano, New England Conservatory, Boston; former chair of the NEC piano department for more than ten years. Also taught at Mannes College, New York, Eastman School of Music, Brandeis University, Boston's Longy School of Music, where he served as director / president. Has performed widely as soloist and in chamber ensembles in the USA, Europe, Asia, and Israel, and Russia, in such prestigious halls as Alice Tully Hall in New York and the Hermitage in St. Petersburg. Has collaborated with such artists as Leonard Rose, Arnold Steinhardt, Robert Mann, and the Cleveland and Brentano String Quartets, among others. Festival appearances have included Tanglewood, Rockport, Yellow Barn, Kneisel Hall, Kfar Blum (Israel), among others. Also an accomplished composer and conductor, he gives masterclasses and lectures on pedagogy issues and interpretive analysis worldwide. His acclaimed recording of Schubert is on Bridge Records.

Rosenbaum's musical genealogy reaches back all the way to Beethoven: his principal teacher was Leonard Shure, a pupil of Artur Schnabel, who studied with Theodor Leschetizky, a pupil of Carl Czerny, who was a student and friend of Beethoven.
